Mark 4:35-41

Discuss:

- How can you trust God with situations that get out of control or seem hopeless?
- What do you want to remember the next time your life seems out of control?

Memorize:

Isaiah 41:10, "Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

Sing:

Pray:

Discuss:

- How does knowing who God is help you face your fears?

Memorize:

Discuss:

- In doing God's work, do you feel like a "grasshopper"? How so? How will your memory of God's past help affect the way you face present difficulty?

Memorize:

Isaiah 41:10, "Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

Sing:
