Discuss:

Retell the story in your own words.

What is the main point of Jesus parable? V1

Why do people stop praying? When are you tempted to stop praying?

What does it mean to be persistent in our prayers?

Memorize:

Jeremiah 33:3, "Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known."

Sing:

Pray: Thank God that He is a just, loving, and wise God who hears and responds to prayer. Pray that God will help you not to give up in prayer.

Read:

Luke 18:9-14

Discuss:

Who were the two people in the story? What reputation do these two groups have?

How are the two prayers different?

What is the point of the parable Jesus is telling?

Why do you think God values humility and opposes the proud?

Memorize:

Pray:

Thank God that he can forgive anyone and ask him to help you to be grow proud.

Read

Luke 11:1-4

Discuss:

If you could ask Jesus to teach you to do something, what would that be? What did the disciples ask?

Point out the many different ways we are to pray. Discuss each of these and the things we can prayer for related to these.

Praise (Hallowed be your name)
Priority: Your kingdom come

Provision: Give us each day our daily bread

Pardon: Forgive us our sins

Protection: lead us to temptation.

Pray: Use the Lord's prayer as a model and pray together.

Read

Luke 11:5-13

Discuss:

Review the Parable.

Memorize:
